NOTES FOR GUIDANCE

It is important that both your vet and you are familiar with the rules before completing the premise check form.

1. The premise check should be completed by your vet
2. A premise check should be completed at all holdings that accredited animals will be held at.
3. If the flock/herd is being established from accredited stock it is recommended that the premise check is completed prior to the arrival of accredited animals to ensure it meets the requirements of the scheme
4. Section 1 ,2 and 3 should be completed for all flocks/herds. A health status report will not be issued unless the stock numbers are filled in fully.
5. Section 4 should be completed for flocks that are being established from accredited sources. You should have proof in the form of health status reports that the animals are from accredited flocks
6. Section 5A should be completed for all flock/herds and section 5B if there are non accredited stock on the holding.
7. Please ensure you and your vet both read and sign section 6. The form is invalid without these signatures.
