Congratulations – it's a Silver for Blackberry Farm!

Blackberry Farm Stables have recently been issued with a Silver Status Certificate! This means that they have an annual declaration that they are adhering to PASS biosecurity guidelines.



Blackberry Farm Stables is located South of Dunbar and first joined PASS in 2014 when they carried out a whole yard test . The yard itself is located half a mile from Thorntonloch beach and they have lots of local hacking and their very own 1KM Exercise Gallop!

Three Health Status Levels to suit all yards!

Gold status requires annual retesting of all your horses, to give the highest level of assurance of freedom from disease.

Silver status requires whole-yard testing at the outset followed by annual declaration of compliance with scheme guidelines

NEW Bronze requires declaration of freedom from clinical signs of Strangles on the yard for a minimum period of the last 2 years, followed by annual declaration of adherence to scheme guidelines. **Which one are you?**
