

**Johne's Management Options Chart** *Choose one or more options in each row*

<p><b>Testing</b></p>	<p>Whole herd screen every other year -if herd clear. <input type="checkbox"/></p>	<p>Annual whole herd screen -if had positives in last 5 yrs. <input type="checkbox"/></p>	<p>Re-test inconclusives 1-3 months after herd screen. <input type="checkbox"/></p>	<p>Twice yearly whole herd screen. <input type="checkbox"/></p>
<p><b>Cow management</b></p>	<p>Isolate test positives -if possible at separate "dirty ground" location. <input type="checkbox"/></p>	<p>Delayed cull of test positives -after calf reared (beef) -after lactation (dairy). <input type="checkbox"/></p>	<p>Isolate inconclusives -Isolate separately from positive cows if may be returned to main herd. <input type="checkbox"/></p>	<p>Immediate cull of test positives. <input type="checkbox"/></p>
<p><b>Calf management</b></p>	<p>Calve positive cows in separate location from clean cows. <input type="checkbox"/></p>	<p>Keep calves away from test positive cows. -snatch calves (dairy). <input type="checkbox"/></p>	<p>Optimise calving hygiene -provide clean calving areas with fresh bedding. <input type="checkbox"/></p>	<p>Consider culling daughter lines from test-positive cows. <input type="checkbox"/></p>
<p><b>Replacement management</b></p>	<p>Screen bought in stock including hired bulls -isolate pending results. <input type="checkbox"/></p>	<p>Do not keep calves from positive dams as replacements. <input type="checkbox"/></p>	<p>Purchase replacements from accredited free sources. <input type="checkbox"/></p>	<p>Consider moving towards closed herd in the longer term. <input type="checkbox"/></p>
<p><b>Environmental management</b></p>	<p>Provide clean water -provide piped water in raised troughs -fence off standing water. <input type="checkbox"/></p>	<p>Slurry management -do not spread slurry that may have come from infected stock onto grazing pastures. <input type="checkbox"/></p>	<p>Reduce bacteria in high risk areas -where positive cows have been housed (disinfect sheds) or grazed (lime fields). <input type="checkbox"/></p>	<p>Consider role of other animals -avoid co-grazing sheep from positive farms. -consider wildlife management. <input type="checkbox"/></p>
