Membership Reminder!

Please would you check that your PASS Membership Certificate is up to date. Please check below what you need to do to retain your membership for relevant health status. The PASS subscription has been frozen at £50/year with discounted rates for testing when required £28.90.

There are three levels of scheme membership:

Gold Accredited status - annual retesting of all horses

Silver Monitored status - whole-yard testing at the start then annual declaration of compliance with scheme guidelines each year

Bronze Monitored status - declaration of freedom from clinical signs of Strangles on the yard for at least the last 2 years, and annual declaration of adherence to scheme guidelines.
