


- Launched in 2011

High Standards

- > Robust science
- > Transparent Registry
- > Independent Validation/ Verification








Requirements

- UK Forestry Standard +
- Additionality
 - Legal : Financial : Barrier
- Permanence
 - Forestry Act, EIA regs,
 - Risk assessment, Buffer (20% of project CO₂)
 - Require restock if losses to wind, fire, pest & disease, development
- Predict and monitor carbon sequestration
 - Baseline : Leakage : Project benefit
- Carbon Statements & Reporting



Woodland Benefits Tool

- Questions on woodland design/management
- Score out of 5
- Consistent description from all projects





Validation and Verification

Validation

- At the outset
- Meets the standard (incl UKFS)
- Validate carbon prediction





Monitoring

- After year 5 and every 10 years
- Field survey
- Assess carbon stock


Verification

- After year 5 and every 10 years up to 100 years/project length
- Meets the standard (incl UKFS)
- Verify actual carbon sequestration

- Predict Carbon sequestration up to 100 years:
 - 'C Lookup Tables' based on Forest Research models & ESC
- Measure carbon sequestration as trees grow:
 - 'Carbon Assessment Protocol' sets out monitoring methods



Registry of carbon units

- Each unit has unique serial number
- Track issuance, ownership, transfer and use

Pending Issuance Units

- 'Promise to deliver'
- Not guaranteed
- Can only make CSR statements about future sequestration

→ Converted upon verification to →

Woodland Carbon Units

- Actual measured sequestration (=ex-post)
- Guaranteed (with buffer)
- Can be used as offset/compensation




UK as of 30 Sep 2018:

- 240 Projects registered
- 21,143 ha woodland
- 6.6 MtCO₂ over lifetime
- 191 projects validated
- 20,582 ha woodland
- 6.4 MtCO₂ over lifetime

- 56 projects verified yr 5
- 2,207 ha woodland
- 1.0M tCO₂ over lifetime
- > 34 Proj Dev -registered project
- > 24 Proj Dev -validated projects
- > > 70 Corporate Buyers



UK Policy 2018

HM Government

- 1,000 UK companies have to report GHG emissions
- Expanded to 12,000 next year?

Companies can use verified credits:

- To compensate for emissions
- To claim carbon neutrality

UK Policy documents promise:

- Stronger domestic carbon offset market
- Woodland C Guarantee: £50M/ 30 yrs



Raising awareness, reducing bills, saving carbon

UK-based corporates for CSR or to compensate for their UK-based emissions

WCC projects also deliver...

For each tonne of CO₂ sequestered (Eftec, 2016):

- £20-£90 of **biodiversity** benefit
- £64-£75 of recreation benefit
- £10 of air quality regulation benefit
- Support economic activity by increasing Gross Value Added by £7.38

Other ecosystem services:

- 12.5% of woodlands water pollution/flood risks priority areas
- 1 or 2 projects accessible to deprived communities



Craigengillan, Ayrshire

- 210 ha, native woodland
- previously rough pasture for grazing
- Project Developer: Eamonn Wall → Watston Forestry
- Will sequester 81,000 tCO₂ over 100 years
 - 65,000 tCO₂ for sale,
 - 16,000 tCO₂ to buffer
- UNESCO Biosphere
- Observatory in 'Gold' Dark Sky Park
- Chance to participate in conservn
- & community projects
- Education (schools, scouts...)
- Recreation (17 miles footpath)





Waitrose

Waitrose

- Since 2011 with Woodland Trust
- Will compensate for emissions of home delivery fleet over time
- Bought carbon at Warcop, an MOD site in an AONB, Cumbria
- Have bought over 22,000 carbon units

Why?

- They believe in trees, value the biodiversity, environmental, recreation & flood control benefits
- Raises Waitrose's environmental and CSR credentials
- Strong marketing messages to convey to stakeholders
- Staff engagement through tree planting







More widely

- Global: Gold Standard: 'Stacking' credits for
 - Carbon, Water, Health
- Globally other landuses sell GHG emissions reductions
 - Sustainable agriculture/grassland management
 - Livestock/manure management
 - → Verra, Gold Standard, Australian Emissions Reduction Fund, Climate Action Reserve



Restoration of degraded peatlands



- Scottish Agriculture : Agricarbon
 - Soil C tool demo 2019: Near-InfraRed spectroscopy
 - Developing ecosystem services marketplace → Green Alliance

- WCC: private sector money to landowners for carbon sequestration
- It's the sequestration that's monetised
- Projects deliver many other public goods
- Need policy drivers for the landowner and buyer
- Could be applied to other public goods/ landuses
