Dairy costings

From this information, monthly changes in milk output and income can be easily tracked.





MilkNET

MilkNET is an internet-based, interactive dairy costing system which allows farmers to track and benchmark herd output and financial performance on a monthly basis. Herds can also be benchmarked against others based on herd size and annual yield information. The online portal operates on the milk quota year from 1st April – 31st March. It can record physical and financial information about the dairy herd and enables benchmarking total gross output from milk sales, whilst deducting costs of bought in feeds.

We evaluate data from the following feeding efficiency KPI's:

- · Milk from forage
- · Concentrate use per cow
- Concentrate use per litre
- · Margin over concentrates per cow
- · Margin over concentrates per litre

These efficiency measures allow assessment of milk production efficiency and can identify areas for improvement when benchmarked against similar herds. MilkNet can also be used to forecast future milk production and produce a full Cost of Production report.
