### By Bus

There are limited services from Dumfries to Parkgate. If you are travelling from the North, most buses from Glasgow/Edinburgh travel through Parkgate enroute to Dumfries.

There is no direct bus service from Lockerbie to Parkgate. If you arrive at Lockerbie station and want to travel to Parkgate by bus, it will be necessary to go via Dumfries.

### By Car

#### From the M74

Leave at **Junction 15 from the north (southbound)** take the 3<sup>rd</sup> exit at the first roundabout, under the motorway, then take the 1<sup>st</sup> exit at the second roundabout, following signs for the A701 Dumfries. **From the south (northbound)** take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit following signs for the A701 Dumfries.

**Then**, continue with the A701 until just past Nethermill where the campus is signposted off to the left. Follow this road (C19n) for about half a mile, turning right onto campus at the entrance signs.

#### From Dumfries

Follow signs for the A701 to Edinburgh and Glasgow. Continue until Parkgate where the campus is signposted off to the right. Follow this road (C19n) for about half a mile, turning right onto campus at the entrance signs.

### By Train (then onward travel)

#### Via Lockerbie or Dumfries

The closest railway stations are Dumfries and Lockerbie. Lockerbie is on the West Coast Main Line with direct services to Glasgow, Edinburgh, Carlisle, Manchester and London. Please note that onward bus travel from Lockerbie is primarily via Dumfries. From Dumfries railway station, there are regular services to/from Carlisle, Kilmarnock and Glasgow with connecting services to Ayr and Stranraer.
