What do you need to get started?

For our entry level (SCQF L5), a satisfactory level of literacy & numeracy is required.

What will you be doing?

During your time as a Modern Apprentice you will spend the majority of your time in the workplace, with dedicated time set aside to concentrate on your studies, fully supported both by your employer and us as your training provider. Access to training material, knowledgeable academic staff and the support of your fellow students and peers will help you succeed. Being part of the SRUC cohort at your local campus means you will have access to a full range of resources just like our full-time students, giving you the best of both worlds while you earn a wage and gain valuable work experience.

What will you gain?
